

SECTION 09510 - ACOUSTICAL CEILINGS

1. DO NOT INSTALL ACOUSTICAL CEILINGS UNTIL THE SPACE TO RECEIVE THEM HAS BEEN ENCLOSED, AND WEATHER-TIGHT UNIL WORK ABOVE CEILING HAS BEEN COMPLETED, AND UNLILAMMENT CONDITIONS OF TEMPERATURE AND HUMIDITY WILL BE CONTINUOUSLY MAINTAINED AT VALUES NEAR THOSE INDICATED FOR FINAL OCCUPANCY.

2. ACOUSTICAL UNITS WHERE INDICATED: ACOUSTICAL PANELS 48" X 48" 3256 OPTIMA 9'16" SQUARE TIGULAR LAY-IN TILES BY ARMSTRONG WORLD INDUSTRIES OR EQUAL BY USG, OR CELEST.

3. SUSPENSION SYSTEM FOR LOCATIONS WITH ACOUSTICAL PANELS: TRELLIDE 15/16 INCH EXPOSED BESSYSTEM BY ARMSTRONG WORLD INDUSTRIES OR APPROVED EQUAL BY CHIEGO METALIC. SYSTEM SHALL HAVE A MEDIUM DUTY CLASSIFICATION COMPLYING WITH ASIM C636.

4. HANGER WIRE: GALVANIZED, 12 GAGES OF ANNEALED.

5. ACCESSORIES: DEVICES FOR ATTACHMENT TO OVERHEAD CONSTRUCTION, SECONDARY MEMBERS, SPINES, SPLICES, CONNECTION SURS, WALL CONNECTIONS, COMPRESSION STRUTS AND ALL OTHER DEVICES REQUIRED FOR A COMPLETE INSTALLATION.

6. TRIM: SPECIAL TRIM AS SHOWN OR REQUIRED BY CONSTRUCTION, AND COMPATIBLE WITH DESIGN, APPEARANCE AND DURABILITY RATING OF CEILING. TRIM AT PERIMETER AND PENETRATIONS SHALL PERMIT A TYPICAL ADJUSTMENT TO FIT AT LEAST 1/2" TO ACCOMMODATE DIFFERENTIALS IN VERTICAL SURFACES INTERFERING CEILING.

7. FINISH EXPOSED SURFACES OF METAL GRID AND ACCESSORIES: PRIME AND PAINT WITH A BASED ON ENAMEL FINISH COLOR WHITE.

8. CODICES AND STANDARDS: INSTALL MATERIALS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THEIR MANUFACTURERS PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS, ASIM C636, AND TO COMPLY WITH GOVERNING REGULATIONS AND INDUSTRY STANDARDS APPLICABLE TO THIS WORK.

9. LAYOUT PLAN: LAYOUT TO BALANCE BORDER WIDTHS AT PROPOSED EDGES OF EACH CEILING AREA. AVOID USE OF LESS THAN HALF WIDTH UNITS WHEREVER POSSIBLE. COMPLY WITH ARCHITECTS REQUIRED CEILING PLANS.

10. ALLOWABLE TOLERANCE: MAXIMUM DEVIATION FROM LEVEL AND FLAT OF THE COMPLETED CEILING SHALL NOT EXCEED 1/8" IN 10 FT WHEN MEASURED WITH A STRAKE HEDGE PLACED AT ANY LOCATION ON THE CEILING; 1/4" TOTAL DEVIATION WITHIN ANY SINGLE AREA.

11. ACOUSTICAL UNITS: MATCH TILE FOR COLOR AND PATTERN BY USING TILE FROM CARTONS IN THE SAME SEQUENCE AS MANUFACTURED.

12. SCORE AND CUT UNITS FOR ACCURATE FIT AT BORDERS AND AROUND WORK WHICH PENETRATES CEILING.

13. WHERE UNITS ABUT WALL SURFACES AND REST ON HANG OF EDGE MOLDING, INSERT JIFFY CLIP BEHIND EACH ACOUSTICAL UNIT.

14. INSTALL HOLD-DOWN CLIPS AT EXTERIOR DOORS TO PREVENT PANEL UPLIFT OR FLUTTER FROM AIR MOVEMENT.

SECTION 09650 - RESILIENT TILE FLOORING

1. MAINTAIN TEMPERATURE IN SPACES TO RECEIVE RESILIENT FLOORING AND BASES BETWEEN 70°F AND 90°F FOR NOT LESS THAN 24 HOURS BEFORE AND 48 HOURS AFTER ITS INSTALLATION.

2. MAINTAIN MINIMUM TEMPERATURE OF 60°F AFTER RESILIENT FLOORING HAS BEEN INSTALLED, EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED ABOVE.

3. RESILIENT FLOORING: SIZE, STYLE AND COLOR AS INDICATED ON DRAWINGS.

4. BASE: RUBBER RUBBER WALL BASE, COLORS AS INDICATED ON DRAWINGS. BASE SHALL BE COVETIVE AT RESILIENT FLOORING CONDITION AND CARPET BASE AT CARPET LOCATIONS.

5. EDGE TRIM: TAPERED HARD RUBBER EDGE TRIM MADE BY THE MANUFACTURER SPECIFIED FOR BASE AND OF COLORS AS INDICATED ON DRAWINGS.

6. PRIMER ADHESIVE AND CRACK FILLER: TYPE RECOMMENDED BY RESILIENT MATERIALS MANUFACTURER FOR THE CONDITIONS OF USE.

7. EXAMINE SUBSTRATES FOR EXCESSIVE MOISTURE CONTENT AND UNDESIRABLE WHICH WOULD PREVENT THE PROPER EXECUTION OF THE WORK OF THIS SECTION. FILL CRACKS AND CRACK DOWN RUNS THAT WOULD DEFLECT THE TRAFFIC THROUGH THE RESILIENT FLOORING.

8. REMOVE DIRT, OIL, GREASE, OR OTHER FOREIGN MATTER FROM SURFACES TO RECEIVE RESILIENT FLOORING.

9. APPLY ADHESIVE UNIFORMLY OVER BACKING SURFACES, BUT ONLY ON AREAS WHICH CAN BE COVERED BY FLOORING MATERIAL WITHIN THE RECOMMENDED WORKING TIME OF THE ADHESIVE.

10. INSTALL RESILIENT TILE IN ACCORDANCE WITH MANUFACTURERS PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS.

11. MATCH TILES FOR COLOR AND PATTERN, WHEN APPLICABLE, BY USING TILE FROM CARTONS IN THE SAME SEQUENCE AS MANUFACTURED AND PACKAGED.

12. INSTALL TILE WORKING FROM CENTER LINES OF EACH ROOM OR SPACE AND WORK OUTWARD TOWARD THE PERIMETER IN STRAIGHT LINES PARALLEL TO ROOM AXIS, EXCEPT WHEN IMPRACTICAL BECAUSE OF ROOM SHAPE. DO NOT INSTALL TILE WATERS THAN 1/2 THE WIDTH OF A FULL SIZE TILE.

13. TILES NEATLY AND TIGHTLY INTO BREAKS AND RECESSES, AGAINST BASES, AROUND PIPES AND PENETRATIONS, UNDER MECHANICALS, HOLES AND AROUND PERMANENT FIXTURE AND EQUIPMENT.

14. ROLL FLOORING INTO ADHESIVE WITH HEAVY ROLLER TO ELIMINATE AIR POCKETS AND TO THOROUGHLY BOND TO THE SUBSTRATE TAKE PARTICULAR CARE TO ROLL EDGES AND CORNERS THOROUGHLY.

15. RUBBER BASE: MATCH EDGES AT JOINTS TO A HANDLINE. APPLY ADHESIVE AND FIRMLY ADHERE TO WALL. DO NOT USE PREFORMED CORNERS.

16. EDGE TRIM: INSTALL AT TERMINATION OF FLOOR OR TILE WHERE THE TILES NOT COVERED BY ANOTHER MATERIAL. GLESS SECURELY TO CLEAN, DRY SUBFLOOR. INSTALL IN ONE PIECE BETWEEN DOOR JAMBS, AND IN LONG SPOTS WHERE LIES SHOW HERE.

17. FOR GROUT/TILE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS & SPECIFICATIONS, REFER TO FINISH FLOOR PLAN.

SECTION 09660 - RESILIENT SHEET FLOORING

1. MOISTURE TEST: PRIOR TO INSTALLATION, CONDUCT A RMA CALCULUM CHLORIDE TEST ON CONCRETE SLABS TO RECEIVE RESILIENT SHEET FLOORING. MAXIMUM MOISTURE EMISSION LEVEL: 3 POUNDS OF WATER PER 1000 SQUARE FEET OF SLAB IN A 24-HOUR PERIOD.

2. MAINTAIN A TEMPERATURE OF NOT LESS THAN 70°F OR MORE THAN 95°F IN SPACES TO RECEIVE PRODUCTS FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS BEFORE INSTALLATION, DURING INSTALLATION, AND FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS AFTER INSTALLATION.

3. DO NOT INSTALL FLOORING OVER CONCRETE SLABS UNTIL SLABS HAVE CURED AND ARE SUFFICIENTLY DRY TO BOND WITH ADHESIVE AS DETERMINED BY MOISTURE TEST.

4. REMOVE COATINGS, INCLUDING CURING COMPOUNDS, AND OTHER SUBSTANCES THAT ARE INCOMPATIBLE WITH FLOORING ADHESIVES AND THAT CONTAIN SOAP, WAX, OIL, OR SILICONE, USING MECHANICAL METHODS RECOMMENDED BY MANUFACTURER. DO NOT USE SOLVENTS.

5. ROOM AND VACUUM CLEAN SUBSTRATES TO BE COVERED IMMEDIATELY BEFORE PRODUCT INSTALLATION. AFTER CLEANING, EXAMINE SUBSTRATES FOR MOISTURE, ALKALINE SALTS, CARBONATION, OR DUST. DO NOT PROCEED WITH INSTALLATION UNTIL UNSATISFACTORY CONDITIONS HAVE BEEN CORRECTED.

6. APPLY TWO LAYERABLE LEVING AND PATCHING COMPOUND TO FILL CRACKS, HOLES, AND DEPRESSIONS IN SUBSTRATES. PLANI PATCH P110 BY MAPLE OR EQUIVALENT.

7. ADHESIVES: WATER-RESISTANT TYPE RECOMMENDED BY MANUFACTURER TO SUIT RESILIENT PRODUCTS AND SUBSTRATE CONDITIONS INDICATED.

8. METAL EDGE STRIPS: EXTRUDED ALUMINUM WITH MILL FINISH OF WIDTH SHOWN, OTHERWISE REQUIRED TO PROTECT EXPOSED EDGE OF SHEET VINYL, AND IN MAXIMUM AVAILABLE LENGTHS TO MINIMIZE JOINTS.

9. COVER STRIP: 1-INCH RADII SUPPORT FOR INTERLURAL RASH COVER BASE PROVIDED OR APPROVED BY FLOOR COVERING MANUFACTURER.

10. COVER BASE CAP STRIP: SQUARE METAL, VINYL, OR RUBBER CAP FOR INTERLURAL RASH COVER BASE PROVIDED OR APPROVED BY FLOOR COVERING MANUFACTURER.

11. COMPLY WITH SHEET VINYL FLOOR COVERING MANUFACTURERS WRITTEN INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS.

12. UNROLL SHEET VINYL FLOOR COVERINGS AND ALLOW THEM TO STABILIZE BEFORE CUTTING AND FITTING. IF RECOMMENDED IN WRITING BY MANUFACTURER.

13. MAINTAIN UNIFORMITY OF SHEET VINYL FLOOR COVERING. DIRECTIION WITH MINIMUM NUMBER OF SEAMS AND PLACE IN CONSPICUOUS AND LOW TRAFFIC AREAS AND NOT LESS THAN 6 INCHES AWAY FROM PARALLEL JOINTS IN FLOORING SUBSTRATES.

14. MATCH EDGES OF SHEET VINYL FLOOR COVERINGS FOR COLOR SHADING AND PATTERN AT SEAMS ACCORDING TO MANUFACTURERS WRITTEN RECOMMENDATIONS.

SECTION 09900 - PAINTING

1. PAINT ALL EXPOSED SURFACES BOTH NEW AND EXISTING, THROUGHOUT THE PROJECT, EXCEPT AS EXCLUDED IN PARAGRAPH 4 BELOW.

2. SURFACE PREPARATION, PRIMING AND COATS OF PAINT SPECIFIED ARE IN ADDITION TO SHOP PRIMING AND SURFACE TREATMENTS SPECIFIED IN OTHER SECTIONS.

3. PAINT ALL EXPOSED SURFACES WHETHER OR NOT COLORS ARE DESIGNATED, EXCEPT WHERE THE NATURAL FINISH OF THE MATERIALS IS OBVIOUSLY EXTENDED OR SPECIFICALLY NOTED AS A SURFACE NOT TO BE PAINTED. WHERE ITEMS OR SURFACES ARE NOT SPECIFICALLY MENTIONED, PAINT THESE THE SAME AS ADJACENT SIMILAR MATERIALS OR AREAS.

4. PAINTING NOT EXCLUDED: THE FOLLOWING SURFACES ARE NOT TO BE PAINTED OR THEIR PAINTING IS EXCLUDED IN OTHER SECTIONS OF THESE SPECIFICATIONS:

4.1. SHOP PRIMING OF FERROUS METAL ITEMS EXCLUDED UNDER MISCELLANEOUS METALS, FLOW WELD WORK, AND SIMILAR WORK.

4.2. FINISHED (NOT PRIMED) MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT INCLUDING LIGHT FIXTURES, SWITCHGEAR AND DISTRIBUTION CABINETS.

4.3. FACTORY FINISHED ITEMS SUCH AS (BUT NOT LIMITED TO) FINISH HARDWARE AND SIO REFRONT.

4.4. FINISHED METAL SURFACES SUCH AS ANODIZED ALUMINUM, STAINLESS STEEL, CHROME PLATING, COPPER, BRONZE, BRASS AND SIMILAR FINISHED MATERIALS WILL NOT REQUIRE FINISH PAINTING.

4.5. PAINTING IS NOT REQUIRED ON WALLS OR CEILING IN CONCEALED AND INACCESSIBLE AREAS SUCH AS RURED AREAS AND PIPE SPACES.

4.6. OPERATING PARTS AND LARERS.

5. ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS: COMPLY WITH MANUFACTURERS RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS REGARDING PAINT APPLICATION. DO NOT APPLY FINISH IN AREAS WHERE DUST RISING IS PROBABLE.

6. QUALITY AND MANUFACTURE: USE BEST QUALITY GRADE REGULARLY MANUFACTURED BY ONE OF THE MANUFACTURERS LISTED BELOW. UNLESS BRUSH COATS ARE PROVIDED TO OWNER FOR SIGNED APPROVAL OF SUBSTITUTION, INNOVATIVE PRACTICES AT EACH PAINT SHALL BE FACTORY MIXED TO MATCH APPROVED SAMPLES AND COLORS, AND BE OF A CONSISTENCY PERMITTING IMMEDIATE APPLICATION.

7. PAINT COMPATIBILITY: PROVIDE FINISH COATS COMPATIBLE WITH THE PRIME COATS USED. REVIEW OTHER SECTIONS OF THESE SPECIFICATIONS IN WHICH PRIME COATS ARE SPECIFIED AND BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COMPATIBILITY OF THE TOTAL COATING SYSTEM.

8. ALL PAINT SPECIFICATIONS TO BE PER SCHEDULE NO. EXCEPTIIONS ARE ALLOWED.

9. PREPARE SURFACES TO RECEIVE THE SPECIFIED FINISHES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PAINT MANUFACTURERS PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS AND ESTABLISHED INDUSTRY STANDARDS.

10. REMOVE ALL HARDWARE, HARDWARE ACCESSORIES, MACHINED SURFACES, PLATES, LIGHTING FIXTURES AND SIMILAR ITEMS IN PLACE AND NOT TO BE PAINTED, OR PROVIDE SURFACE APPLIED PROTECTIVE PROTECT TO SURFACE PREPARATION AND PAINTING. FOLLOWING COMPLETION OF PAINTING, EACH SPACE OR AREA, REINSTALL THE REMOVED ITEM BY WORKMEN SKILLED IN THE TRADES INVOLVED.

11. APPLY PAINT ONLY UNDER CONDITIONS THAT WILL ENSURE FINISHES FREE FROM BLEMISHES AND DEFECTS. MAKE FINISH COATS SMOOTH, FREE OF BRUSH MARKS, STRIATIONS, LAPS OR STRIPS, AND MISSED AREAS. LEAVE ALL CORNERS WITH NO UNDERMOUNT OF PAINTED FILT.

12. PRIMER AND INTERMEDIATE COATS SHALL BE UNSCARRED AND COMPLETELY UNIFORM WHEN SUCCEEDING COATS ARE APPLIED. SAND AND DUST BETWEEN EACH COAT TO REMOVE DEFECTS, VESICLES FROM A DESIGN OF FEEZ.

13. REMOVE PAINT SPILLAGE AND SPATTERS ON ADJACENT SURFACES SO AS NOT TO DAMAGE THE SURFACE BEING CLEANED. PERFORM ALL PATCHING AND REPAIRS REQUIRED BEFORE PAINTING OPERATIONS. REFINISH ENTIRE PANEL OR ASSEMBLY WHERE PORTION OF FINISH HAS BEEN DAMAGED OR IS NOT ACCEPTABLE TO THE OWNER.

14. PAINT INTERIOR SURFACES OF DUCTS WITH A FLAT NON-SPECULAR BLACK PAINT WHERE VISIBLE THROUGH REGISTERS AND GRILES.

15. THE NUMBER OF COATS SPECIFIED IS THE MINIMUM REQUIRED FOR COMPLETE COVERAGE AND UNIFORMITY OF COLOR. APPLY ADDITIONAL COATS WHEN UNDER COATS, STAINS, OR OTHER CONDITIONS SHOW THROUGH THE FINAL FINISH UNTIL THE FINISH IS OF UNIFORM COLOR AND APPEARANCE.

16. COMPLETELY COVER SURFACES TO BE PAINTED TO PROVIDE AN OPAQUE, SMOOTH SURFACE OF UNIFORM FINISH COLOR, APPEARANCE, AND COVERAGE. PAINTED SURFACES WITH CLOUDINESS, SPOTTING, HOLIDAYS, LAPS, BRUSH MARKS, BLENDS, SAGS, DIPS OR OTHER IMPERFECTIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTABLE.

17. TO ESTABLISH A STANDARD OF QUALITY, THE PRODUCTS OF BENJAMIN MOORE ARE SPECIFIED ON THE FINISH SCHEDULE SHEET A1.1 UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.

SECTION 09980 - FRP WALL PANELS

1. PROVIDE FIBERGLASS REINFORCED PLASTIC PANELS AND RELATED TRIM.

2. FRP PANELS: MARLITE WHITE PEBBLE FINISH OR EQUAL.

3. MOLDINGS: DIVISION BARS, INSIDE CORNERS, TOP AND BOTTOM EDGE CAPS, PVC IN MATCHING WHITE COLOR.

4. ADHESIVE: # 1160 FRP ADHESIVE.

5. INSPECT SURFACES TO RECEIVE FRP COVERING AND MAKE SURE THAT CONDITIONS DEERIMENTAL TO ITS PROPER AND TIMELY INSTALLATION ARE CORRECTED BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH INSTALLATION. DO NOT INSTALL IF THE SUBSTRATE HAS MORE THAN A 4 PERCENT MOISTURE CONTENT WHEN MEASURED WITH A MOISTURE METER.

6. HARDWARE: REMOVE HARDWARE, ACCESSORIES, PLATES, AND SIMILAR ITEMS TO ALLOW FRP TO BE INSTALLED. REPLACE THESE ITEMS UPON COMPLETION OF EACH SPACE.

7. CUTTING: DO ALL CUTTING WITH CARBIDE TIPPED SAW RADIOS OR DIELLERS, OR CUT WITH SNIPS.

8. FOLLOW MANUFACTURERS DIRECTIONS AND THE RECOMMENDED GAP FOR PANEL, BEID AND CORNER JOINTS.

9. EXAMINE EACH SEAM CAREFULLY WHEN COMPLETED. SEAMS SHALL BE VERTICAL AND PERPENDICULAR TO THE FLOOR.

SECTION 10400 - IDENTIFYING DEVICES

1. PROVIDE COORDINATION AND BACKING FOR SIGNAGE PROVIDED BY OWNER/VENDOR.

2. PROVIDE INTERIOR SIGNAGE AS INDICATED ON THE DRAWINGS AND SPECIFIED HEREIN.

3. SIO REFRONT AND/OR STREET FRONT SIGNAGE SIGNAGE WILL BE PROVIDED AND INSTALLED BY OWNER/VENDOR. PROVIDE BACKING, ACCESS AND POWER AS INDICATED ON THE DRAWINGS.

4. REAR ENTRY DOOR IDENTIFICATION WILL BE PROVIDED AND INSTALLED BY OWNER/VENDOR. COORDINATE APPLICATION AND LANDLORD REQUIREMENTS. REFER TO DOOR SCHEDULE ON DRAWINGS.

5. EXTERIOR ENTRANCE DOORS:

5.1. PROVIDE AND INSTALL DIE-CUT PRESSURE-SENSITIVE VINYL INTERNATIONAL SYMBOL OF ACCESSIBILITY BY PHYSICALLY HAND-APPLIED DISABLED PERSON. PROVIDE ONE (1) SYMBOL MOUNTED ON INSIDE OF GLASS AS INDICATED ON THE DRAWINGS.

5.2. COLOR: WHITE GRAPHICS ON CLEAR BACK GROUND OR WHITE GRAPHICS ON BLACK BACK GROUND.

6. RESIDUOMS.

6.1. INSTALL SIGNAGE AT RESTROOM DOORS, AS MANUFACTURED BY BEST SIGN SYSTEMS, MODEL SPHS 200. PROVIDE RAISED BRILLE LETTERING. COMPLY WITH THE DISABLED ACCESS REQUIREMENTS OF THE APPLICABLE BUILDING CODE, ALLOCAL AND STATE CODES AND AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA).

6.2. COLOR: WHITE GRAPHICS ON BLACK BACK GROUND.

7. PROVIDE OTHER IDENTIFYING DEVICES REQUIRED BY LOCAL CODES OR JURISDICTION AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE OWNER.

8. INSTALL SIGNAGE LEVEL, PLUMB AND AT HEIGHT INDICATED, WITH SIGN SURFACES FREE FROM DISORDION AND OTHER DEFECTS.

9. MOUNT USING STANDARD FASTENING METHODS RECOMMENDED BY MANUFACTURER. PROVIDE HEAVY WEIGHT HANGING TEMPLATE TO ESTABLISH SPACING AND TO LOCATE HOLES FOR FASTENERS.

SECTION 10800 - TOILET ROOM ACCESSORIES

1. MANUFACTURERS: THE DRAWINGS AND THESE SPECIFICATIONS ARE BASED ON ACCESSORIES MADE BY BRADLEY CORP. THIS IS TO ESTABLISH THE STANDARD OF QUALITY, FUNCTION AND DESIGN REQUIRED FOR THE PROJECT. EQUIVALENT PRODUCTS BY ACCESSORY SPECIALTIES, INC., BOBBE K WASHROOM EQUIPMENT, INC. AND MCKINNEY/KIDDE, INC. ARE ACCEPTABLE.

2. UNIFORMITY: ALL TOILET ROOM ACCESSORIES INSTALLED ON THE PROJECT SHALL BE PRODUCTS OF ONE MANUFACTURER, EXCEPT AS NOTED.

3. INSTALLATION: SHALL COMPLY WITH THE DISABLED ACCESS REQUIREMENTS OF THE APPLICABLE BUILDING CODE, ALLOCAL AND STATE CODES AND AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA).

4. COMPLY WITH THE APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 01600. KEEP PROTECTIVE COVERS ON ACCESSORIES UNTIL THEIR INSTALLATION IS COMPLETE, THEN REMOVE AT FINAL CLEAN-UP.
